Picture books galore! Here are some new ones coming in:

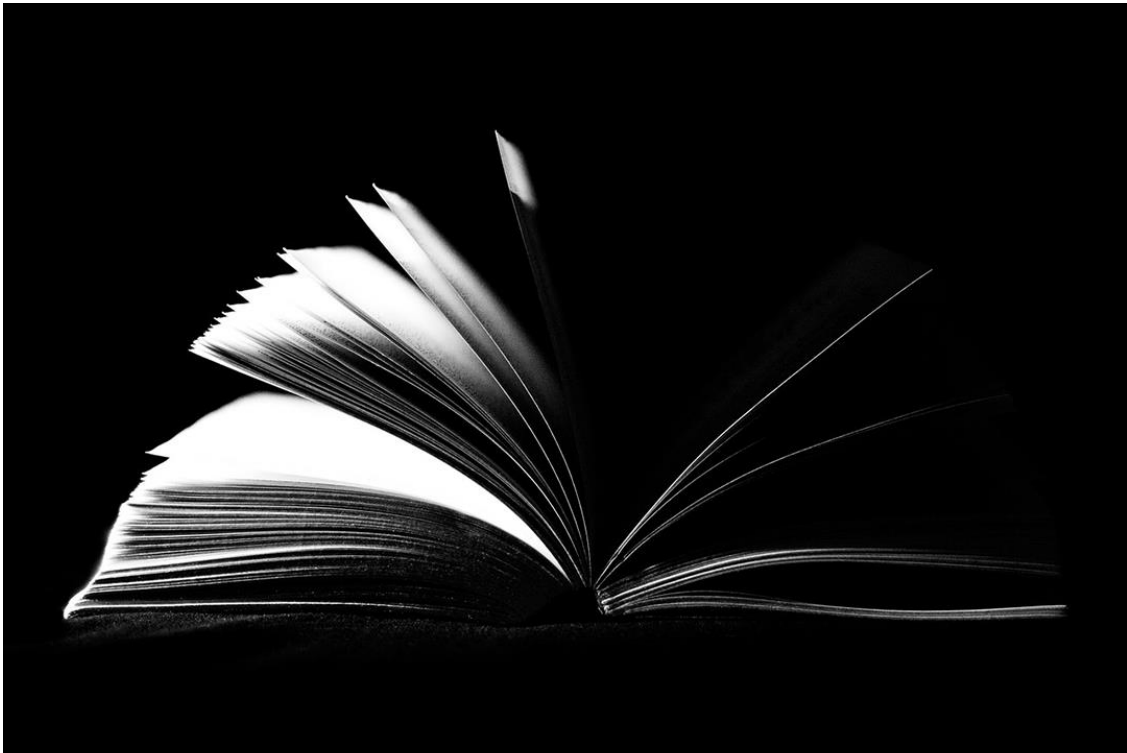
